

GEOGRAPHY

LOCATION

Located at the southern tip of Hainan Island, Sanya is bordered on three sides by neighboring counties: Lingshui Li Autonomous County to the east, Baoting Li and Miao Autonomous County to the north, and Ledong Li Autonomous County to the west. To the south, the city opens onto the vast expanse of the South China Sea. The city spans latitudes $18^{\circ}09'34''N$ to $18^{\circ}37'27''N$ and longitudes $108^{\circ}56'30''E$ to $109^{\circ}48'28''E$. With a maximum east-west stretch of 91.6 kilometers and a north-south span of 51 kilometers, Sanya covers a total land area of 1,921 square kilometers and administers 3,226 square kilometers of maritime territory.


TOPOGRAPHY


Sanya's dramatic topography unfolds between mountain ranges to the north and the South China Sea to the south, forming a narrow elongated corridor that slopes gradually seaward. This $1,921 \text{ km}^2$ coastal city boasts 263 km of coastline dotted with 19 natural harbors, 10 principal islands, and 11 independent rivers that carve through the landscape before meeting the ocean—a convergence of terrestrial and marine ecosystems that creates exceptional biodiversity.

CLIMATE

Sanya is situated in the low-latitude tropical area, renowned for its tropical marine monsoon climate. It is summer there all year round, with an average annual temperature of 25.7°C . Sanya, known as "the city bathed in sunlight", is bathed in the sun for up to 2534 hours a year.


Annual temperature curve






ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS

There are four administrative districts in Sanya, namely Haitang District, Jiyang District, Tianya District and Yazhou District, sitting from west to east. Sanya Municipal People's Government is located at No.257 Xinfeng Street, Jiyang District.





HISTORY

According to archaeological findings, human activities in Sanya date back as early as 10,000 years ago. Known anciently as Yazhou, Sanya boasts a long and profound history. Since the Western Han Dynasty expanded into Hainan, Yazhou has served as the administrative capital under various names—Linzen Commandery, Linzen County, Zhenzhou, Yande, Yazhou, Zhuya Army, Jiyang Army, and Yazhou Directly Administered Prefecture—through successive dynasties including the Han, Northern and Southern Dynasties, Sui, Tang, Song, Yuan, Ming, and Qing. Thus, it earned the reputation of having "a 2,000-year administrative history as the seat of eight dynasties' prefecture." In 1912, the Republic of China abolished Yazhou and renamed it Ya County.

ORIGIN OF THE NAME


Sanya was once called "Sanya" (三丫) because the Sanya River (anciently known as Linchuan River) split into eastern and western branches that converged in a Y-shaped formation. Over time, the name evolved into its current form, as the character "丫" (yā, meaning "fork") shares the same pronunciation as "亞" (yà). With a long history, Sanya was documented as early as the Ming Dynasty in the "Zhengde Qiong Tai Zhi" ("Annals of Qiong under the Zhengde Reign"), where records mention "Sanya Village" and "Sanya District."

SANYA PEOPLE

In 1992, cultural relics authorities conducted an archaeological excavation at the Luobi Cave in Sanya, uncovering traces of human activity. This site remains the southernmost-known Paleolithic cultural site discovered in China to date. Ten thousand years ago, a significant branch of ancient humans thrived in Sanya. The Chinese Academy of Sciences has designated these early inhabitants as the "Sanya People."

ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY OF SANYA

May 19, 1984: The State Council of China approved the dissolution of Ya County and the establishment of Sanya City (county-level).
September 26, 1987: The State Council approved Sanya's upgrade to a prefecture-level city.
December 30, 1987: Sanya officially became a prefecture-level city.
January 25, 2014: The State Council approved the restructuring of Sanya, replacing its six towns with four districts: Jiyang, Tianya, Haitang, and Yazhou.
January 2, 2015: The four new districts were officially inaugurated.



POPULATION

As of the end of 2024, Sanya's permanent resident population reached 1.1161 million (Source: Sanya Municipal People's Government official website). The city has maintained steady population growth alongside continuous improvement in urbanization rates. By the end of 2024, Sanya's urban permanent population stood at 818,000, representing an increase of 17,900 compared to the previous year. The urbanization rate rose to 73.29%, marking a 0.95 percentage point increase year-on-year and exceeding the provincial average by 10.21 percentage points.



LANGUAGES

Sanya primarily uses Mandarin Chinese as its common language, with Hainanese being the predominant local dialect. Other regional languages include Jun, Mai, Li, Huihui, Danzhou, and Tanka dialects. Hainanese belongs to the Min branch of the Sino-Tibetan language family and is spoken by approximately 5 million people in Hainan Province, accounting for about 80% of the island's total population. It is the most widely spoken local dialect across Hainan.

ECONOMY

In 2024, Sanya's gross regional product reached 100.47 billion yuan, marking a year-on-year increase of 3.4% and accounting for 12.7% of Hainan Province's total GDP. By sector, the added value of the primary industry was 11.418 billion yuan (up 3.8%), the secondary industry 14.403 billion yuan (up 17.5%), and the tertiary industry 74.649 billion yuan (up 1.1%), with the three-sector structure ratio at 11.4:14.3:74.3. The city's local general public budget revenue totaled 15.415 billion yuan, growing by 4.6% year-on-year. In 2024, Sanya received a total of more than 26 million overnight tourist visits, representing a year-on-year increase of 1.7%. (Source: Sanya Municipal Bureau of Statistics)



FOLK FESTIVALS

DRAGON HEAD-RAISING DAY

On the Dragon Head-Raising Day, which falls on the second day of the second lunar month, Sanya Dongtian Park always holds grand celebrations. Building on Hainan's traditional folk customs of dragon worship, the festivities incorporate elements of Taoist culture and modern "Blue Ribbon" marine conservation activities. A series of dragon-themed cultural events are held, including the "South China Sea Dragon King Worship Ceremony," "Dragon Water Washing," and "Touching the Dragon's Head."




SANYUESAN FESTIVAL

The Sanyuesan Festival (the third day of the third lunar month), also known as the "Shangsi Festival", is a traditional festival of ethnic minorities in Hainan, such as the Miao and Li people. The Li people refer to this day as "Love day", a time for young men and women to express their affection and admiration for one another. Every year on this day, Sanya hosts grand ethnic celebrations, featuring events such as ethnic song and dance performances, traditional sports competitions, and torchlight singing festivities.



DRAGON BOAT FESTIVAL

On the fifth day of the fifth lunar month, the traditional "Dragon Boat Festival", Sanya hosts grand dragon boat races on the Sanya River and Ningyuan River in the urban area. Locals also observe the custom of "washing in dragon water" (Xi Long Shui) by going to the beach on this day, believing it brings blessings and dispels misfortune.



MID-AUTUMN FESTIVAL

On the night of the Mid-Autumn Festival (the 15th day of the eighth lunar month), Sanya's major beaches bustle with excitement as crowds gather under the moonlight. Families come together by the shore, marking their own little spots in the sand with incense and candles. These spaces are filled with seasonal fruits, drinks, mooncakes, and other festive treats as relatives sit together, admiring the bright full moon and enjoying a joyful, heartwarming celebration.

NANSHAN LONGEVITY CULTURE FESTIVAL

Sanya is renowned as China's "Hometown of Longevity." Since the Double Ninth Festival in 1999, the Nanshan Cultural Tourism Zone in Sanya has been hosting the China Nanshan Longevity Culture Festival annually, with themes such as "Respecting the Elderly and Cherishing the Young" and "Health & Wellness." The festival features activities like photo exhibitions of long-lived elderly residents and forums on longevity and well-being, celebrating the region's tradition of health and longevity.

TIANYA HAIJIAO INTERNATIONAL WEDDING FESTIVAL

The Tianya Haijiao International Wedding Festival is a premier tourism event that combines wedding celebrations, travel, and honeymoon vacations into one grand experience. Each year, it attracts hundreds of newlywed and anniversary couples from across China and around the world to participate in this romantic celebration.



HAINAN INTERNATIONAL TOURISM ISLAND CARNIVAL

Hainan International Tourism Island Carnival, co-hosted by the Hainan Provincial Government and the Ministry of Culture and Tourism, is themed "Happy Island, Holiday Paradise." Featuring a series of large-scale celebrations—including cultural performances, sports competitions, ethnic festivities, and parade floats—the festival encourages island-wide participation, creating a joyous atmosphere for all. Aimed at enriching Hainan's tourism culture, the event showcases the island's diverse heritage and abundant tourism resources, further enhancing the vibrant image of "Hainan International Tourism Island."



CHINESE NEW YEAR IN SANYA

Sanya offers a tropical Chinese New Year like no other. In the ancient Yazhou City, lantern festivals illuminate the streets, while Dadonghai hosts Spring Festival markets with Qiong opera and lion dances, all accompanied by the scent of rice cakes drifting through the air. At night, fireworks light up Sanya Bay as families gather along the shore. For authentic culture, visit Li and Miao villages to experience firewood dances, brocade weaving, and feasts of mountain wine and colorful rice—all wrapped in warm hospitality.



RELIGIOUS BELIEFS

Sanya is home to diverse religious traditions including Buddhism, Taoism, Islam and Christianity. The city's Buddhist heritage centers around Nanshan Temple, which features the world's tallest 108-meter Guanyin Statue of the South China Sea, consecrated in a grand 2005 ceremony. Taoist culture thrives at Dongtian Park, hosting annual "Dragon Head-raising" rituals each second day of the second lunar month. The local Hui community maintains six mosques across Fenghuang Town and other areas, while Christians gather for Sunday services at Hongsha Town's church, collectively showcasing Sanya's rich spiritual landscape.

EXPLORING A CARE-FREE CHILDHOOD






NANSHAN CULTURAL TOURISM ZONE

Nanshan Mountain, an extension of the Wuzhi Mountain range historically known as Ao Mountain, rises 487 meters with undulating ridges draped in lush greenery, overlooking the boundless, misty waters of the South China Sea where mountain and ocean merge in breathtaking harmony. Steeped in Buddhist tradition, this sacred site traces its spiritual significance to scriptures documenting Guanyin Bodhisattva's Twelve Great Vows, particularly the vow to "eternally abide in the South Sea." The Tang Dynasty witnessed its divine connection when eminent monks Jianzhen (en route to Japan) and Kukai (returning from China) both fortuitously landed here during storms, later fulfilling their religious missions. Revered as an auspicious Buddhist sanctuary for centuries, the Nanshan Cultural

Tourism Zone has been developed into China's largest government-approved Buddhist-themed destination and among the first 5A-rated scenic areas, uniquely blending tropical seascapes with profound spiritual heritage. Its iconic attractions include: the Nanshan Temple, the 108-meter-tall Nanshan Guanyin Statue (a monumental sea-view Buddhist sculpture), the Guinness World Record-holding Golden Jade Guanyin; the Thirty-Three Guanyin Hall showcasing Buddhist art, along with the Mercy Garden, Auspicious Garden, Longevity Valley, and Little Moon Bay - collectively forming an unparalleled integration of ecological wonder and cultural pilgrimage.

SANYA DONGTIAN PARK

Sanya Dongtian Park, located at the southern foot of Nanshan Mountain about 40 kilometers west of downtown Sanya with origins dating back to 1187 AD, stands as one of Hainan's most historic attractions and China's southernmost Taoist cultural destination. For over eight centuries, its uniquely picturesque seascapes, mountain vistas, rock formations and cave scenery have earned it the prestigious title of "Qiongya's Eight-Hundred-Year Landscape Wonder," now recognized among China's first batch of 5A-rated tourist sites. This area preserves remarkable historical footprints: Tang Dynasty monk Jianzhen landed here during his fifth attempt to sail eastward to spread Buddhism, leaving an enduring legacy; Huang Daopo, the revolutionary cotton textile innovator of the Song-Yuan transition period, gathered cotton here before sailing abroad to disseminate Yazhou's advanced cotton cultivation and weaving techniques; and Bai Yuchan, the fifth patriarch of Southern Taoism during the Song Dynasty, practiced asceticism and preached here, establishing the site's profound Taoist connections that endure to this day.

TIANYA HAIJIAO SCENIC AREA

The Tianya Haijiao Scenic Area, located 23 kilometers southwest of Sanya, is the city's iconic landmark renowned worldwide for its breathtaking tropical coastal scenery, profound historical significance, and vibrant ethnic culture. 

DUTY-FREE SHOPPING AND SHOPPING CENTERS

HAINAN DUTY-FREE SHOPPING POLICY

To steadily advance the development of the Hainan Free Trade Port and further meet consumers' diverse shopping needs, adjustments will be made to Hainan's duty-free shopping policy for departing island visitors effective November 1, 2025.

It now allows all travelers (domestic and foreign travelers, including residents of Hainan Province) aged 18 and above to make duty-free purchases up to 100,000 yuan (\$14,037) per year, with no limit on the number of transactions, provided they have purchased tickets for departure from Hainan by air or sea, hold valid entry/exit documents, and have actually departed the province.

Hainan residents who have a record of leaving the island within a calendar year may also make unlimited purchases of duty-free goods under the "buy-and-pick-up" system during that year, in accordance with relevant collection requirements. Hainan Island Resident refers to Chinese citizens aged 18 or above who hold one of the following documents: a Hainan ID card, a Hainan residence permit, or a Hainan social security card. It also includes foreign nationals residing and working in Hainan with a valid residence permit.

The optimized range of duty-free items increased from 45 to 47 major categories, including pet supplies, portable musical instruments, micro drones, and small household appliances. Domestic goods such as apparel, footwear, ceramics, scarves, coffee, and tea will be permitted for sale in duty-free shops for departing passengers, with VAT and consumption tax refunded (exempted).

Duty-free shops should have both qualification and authorization to sell offshore tax-free goods.

Duty-Free Product Categories (47 Categories): Jewelry, handicrafts, watches, perfumes, cosmetics, pens, eyewear (including sunglasses), scarves, ties, knitwear, cotton goods, Apparel, footwear, hats, belts, luggage, small leather goods, confectionery, sporting goods, beauty and health equipment, tableware and kitchenware, toys (including strollers), retail-packaged infant formula and complementary foods, coffee (coffee beans; espresso), ginseng products, cereal flakes; wheat germ, grain flour, and other processed foods and dairy products; sweet biscuits; waffles and communion wafers; pastries, biscuits, baked goods, and similar products; health foods; royal jelly preparations; olive oil; diapers; Ceramic products, glassware, small household appliances, household hardware, clocks, adapter plugs, watch straps and bracelets, eyeglass lenses and frames, Class I and II household medical devices, natural honey and other edible animal products, tea, mate tea, and products primarily composed of tea or mate tea; tablets; digital accessories such as mice and keyboards; other portable automatic data processing equipment; small automatic data processing equipment; microcomputers; other data processing equipment; small computers declared as systems; microcomputers declared as systems; electronic consumer products; mobile phones; video game consoles; alcoholic beverages; pet supplies; portable musical instruments.

HAINAN TAX REFUND ON DEPARTURE

Applicable to eligible short-stay foreign, Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan travelers, who shop at marked stores and collect cash at the airport tax refund window upon departure. At the same time, it is necessary to meet the conditions that the amount of tax refund items purchased by foreign travelers in the same store on the same day reaches RMB 200; the tax refund items have not yet been used or consumed, and the packaging is intact; the departure date is not more than 90 days from the date of purchase of the refund items, and the refund items need to be carried out of the country. The stores for departure tax refund are mainly located in Tiansha District, Jiyang District and Haitang Bay District of Sanya City.







WATER SPORTS



Located on the southern coast of China by the South China Sea, Sanya is not only an ideal destination for leisure, but also a paradise for water and underwater sports. The average water visibility ranges from 8 to 16 meters, and can reach up to 25 meters in some areas, so international diving experts unanimously rated it as one of the best diving places in the South Pacific Ocean. LOW-ALTITUDE AVIATION TOUR



Low-altitude tourism is an emerging industry in Sanya. By combining Sanya's unique resource advantages, low-altitude transportation such as helicopters, seaplanes, and powered delta wings allows tourists to soar in the sky and overlook the magnificent mountains, sea, islands, and bays of Sanya.

In addition to multiple air tour routes within Sanya, it is possible to implement 'mountain-sea interaction' by stopping at Wuzhishan Mountain, Ledong, Haikou, and other Hainan cities and counties.

Helicopter sightseeing tour: Novel and exciting, the helicopter sightseeing tour allows tourists to appreciate the different geographical and cultural landscapes of mountains, seas, cities, bays, and islands from the air, opening a three-dimensional, broader world.

Seaplane sightseeing tour: With a long and narrow coast, a wide sea area, and numerous islands, Sanya is very suitable for seaplane tours. The seaplane requires only 800 meters for taking off and landing and can access islands and lakes unreachable by land planes. Flying at altitudes below 1,000 meters, seaplanes offer a close-up view of coastal and island scenery.

SANYA BEACH LOUNGE CHAIRS

1. Yalong Bay — Free Public Lounge Chair Demonstration Area

Important Notes: Free Access: Sun umbrellas and beach chairs are marked with "Free Use" signs; no consumption or accommodation is required to use them.

Well-equipped facilities: Lounge chair zones are set up approximately every 50 meters, equipped with lifeguard stations and free shower facilities.

Coverage: Approximately 60% of the nearly 7-kilometer-long beach is public area. Hotel-exclusive lounge chairs require guests to present proof of accommodation (e.g., Global City, Cactus Resort Hotel).

2. Dadao Bay — Mixed-Use Lounge Chair Area

Distribution Area: A public lounge chair area is located in the middle section of the beach, with both sides managed by hotels (e.g., Shanhaitian Grand Hotel).

Important Notes:

Public Area: Free lounge chairs are available under the shade of coconut trees, but quantities are limited, so arrive early to secure a spot.

Hotel Exclusive: Some lounge chairs are reserved for hotel guests only, clearly marked or separated by barriers.

3. Sanya Bay — Community-Oriented Recreational Beach

Distribution Area: Spanning 20 kilometers, loungers are concentrated in the "Coconut Dream Promenade" section, mostly operated by merchants.

Important Notes:

Consumption-Based Use: Most loungers require consumption (e.g., purchasing coconuts/drinks, approximately 10–30 yuan) or paid rental (20–50 yuan per hour).

Natural Alternative: Free resting is available under coconut groves by laying out your own picnic mat.

Friendly reminder:

High season reminder: Deck chairs are in short supply during holidays, so we recommend arriving before 9:00 a.m. or bringing your own folding chair.

Complaint channel: If you encounter merchants charging illegal fees or occupying the beach, please call the Sanya Tourism Service Hotline at 12345.

Recommendations for bringing your own chair: Choose a lightweight, sand-resistant model and avoid metal parts that may rust when exposed to seawater.



EXCEPTIONAL WELLNESS RETREAT


Sanya is famous for its hot springs and spas, as its warm climate is well-suited for traditional Chinese medicine. In Sanya, you can go for a relaxing dip in one of its numerous natural hot springs, select from a wide variety of spas, enjoy a traditional footbath, or experience all-natural healing from traditional Chinese therapies.

The Nantian Village in Haitang Bay District is home to some of the largest natural hot springs in Sanya. The springs, often called 'The Best Springs in China,' are rich in minerals that are thought to have rejuvenating properties.



Zhuijiang Nantian offers a variety of pools with different purposes. Nantian's pools are all surrounded by vegetation for an authentic natural experience. Here you can experience the massage of the waterfall pool, the aroma of the floral pool, the healing properties of the Chinese herbal pool (which infuses 12 traditional therapeutic herbs), the cool spring pool (which stimulates the body's immune system with its 18-20°C water), and the private couple's pool, surrounded by both a fence for privacy and petals for a romantic atmosphere.


Hot springs in Sanya often come with Garra fish. Also called the 'Kissing Fish' by the locals, the Red Garra feeds on dead skin cells and cuticles. The combs in their mouths stimulate nervous signals and improve circulation, aiding the natural healing process and promoting skin rejuvenation.




TRADITIONAL CHINESE MEDICINE THERAPY

Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) is the culmination of 5000 years of Chinese knowledge and a treasure of its culture. TCM is a great way to rebalance the human body, boost immunity, clear your meridians, and revitalize your organs. Many Chinese come to Sanya for TCM therapy, as the tropical climate here is ideal for treating chronic conditions including arthritis, rheumatic conditions, high cholesterol, and obesity. With the aid of TCM practitioners and dietitians, the healing effect will multiply.

1.ACUPUNCTURE AND MOXIBUSTION

Acupuncture and Moxibustion are two signature therapies of TCM. Acupuncture stimulates the body's qi by applying pressure on specific pressure points of the body using extremely fine needles. Moxibustion uses therapeutic mugwort. Practitioners burn mugwort close to the skin, and use the aroma and stimulation from the heat to treat various ailments.



2.CUPPING THERAPY

One of the most effective therapies in physical therapy, this treatment uses physical stimulation and negative pressure to artificially rupture capillaries, thereby activating the body's stem cell repair function and necrotic blood cell absorption function. This promotes blood circulation, stimulates qi, regulates qi and blood, and ultimately enhances and regulates the body's immune system.



3.GUA SHA

This TCM therapy uses a hard tool (usually made from buffalo horn, jade, or metal) to scrape the surface of the skin. The resulting stimulation increases the circulation of Chi, removes stagnation in one's circulation, and boosts immunity. Gua Sha is traditionally used for patients suffering from high blood pressure, heatstroke, and sore muscles.



4.TUINA MASSAGE

In TCM, massage is applied to pressure points of the body using various specified techniques that accelerate or slow down the flow of qi. In addition to being highly enjoyable, these massages can also help rebalance the body, increase body awareness, and decrease chronic pain.

SPECIAL/LOCAL FLAVORS AND DIETARY ACCOMMODATIONS

SANYA'S TOP 10 RECOMMENDED DISHES



FISHERMAN'S SALTED FISH CASSEROLE

Salted fish is a staple in Hainan's diet, prepared by traditional techniques without using any artificial preservative. The fish has a more condensed flavor and a complex aftertaste. The soup is also extremely savory, and often used to complement fine wine.



COCONUT CHICKEN

Coconut chicken is a signature health food in Sanya. Fresh green coconuts are opened locally to extract the water for the soup base, which is then combined with free-range chickens from Wenchang, Hainan. The chicken is boiled for three minutes until cooked. The chicken meat is tender and infused with coconut aroma, while the soup is clear, refreshing, and sweet. Dipping it in a sauce made with sand ginger and green tangerine enhances its freshness and crispness.



SOUR VINEGAR HOT POT

Sour vinegar originates from Hainan's folk tradition of fermenting leftover wine ingredients into a sour vinegar broth. The pot base is made from the sour juice of secondary fermented wine lees, which is used to cook fresh fish, shellfish, beef offal, and other ingredients. The sour and spicy flavor is refreshing and appetizing, especially when dipped in local yellow lantern chili sauce.



TENGQIAO RIBS

Tengqiao Ribs are made with locally sourced free-range pork. The ribs are seasoned with a variety of spices before slowly fried to perfection. The traditional recipe for Tengqiao spare ribs contains pork. Muslim tourists should choose restaurants that clearly offer halal-certified versions (such as those using beef or chicken as substitutes) and confirm in advance that the cooking utensils are free from cross-contamination.



NANSHAN VEGAN DISH

This dish is prepared with a variety of local materials, including wild herbs and in-season vegetables. In addition, wild-grown fungi are also sourced from Yunnan Province to make this savory and nutritious delicacy.



YANGLAN SOUR FISH SOUP

Prepared with fresh sea fish from nearby oceans, this soup gets its tangy flavor from sour ingredients such as tamarind, star fruit, and pickled bamboo shoots. This acidity perfectly complements the fish.



ARECA FLOWER CHICKEN SOUP

This dish is prepared with chicken raised in areca forests and areca flowers. The soup has digestive therapeutic properties and a salty flavor, while the chicken is tender and mildly sweet.



SANYA SEAFOOD HOTPOT

This hotpot uses local seafood, seasoned only with ginger and garlic shoots. The taste of the sea is preserved in this nutritious and savory dish.



LIZHIGOU GOOSE

This type of goose is known for its soft texture. It is often boiled or stir-fried plain and served with a variety of dipping sauces, which vary by tradition. The livers, intestines, and flippers of the goose are especially prized for their texture.



HAINAN ABALONE

Wild abalone harvested off the coast of Hainan can reach up to 150 grams in weight. The abalone has a distinct umami flavor and a rich, tightly knit texture.



MARBLED TURBAN

Marbled turbans are harvested off the coast of An'you. Typically flash-fried with spicy peppers, the dish has sturdy meat, and the peppers accentuate its umami. It is also prepared without spices to preserve its natural flavor.



FOUR SIGNATURE DISHES OF HAINAN PROVINCE

WENCHANG CHICKEN

As the foremost signature dish, Wenchang chicken originates from Wenchang City. It is made from a special free-range chicken, beloved for its succulence. The chicken is traditionally flash-boiled to preserve its tenderness and served with a spiced dipping sauce.



HELE CRAB

Hele Crab originates from Hele Town near Wanning City. The crab's yellow mustard has an oily texture and a strong aroma. It is usually steamed and served with a ginger and garlic vinegar sauce, or stir-fried with a variety of spices, although locals prefer the former method.



JIAJI DUCK

Jiaji Duck is the result of selective breeding between Chinese and foreign ducks and was first bred in Jiaji City. The meat is very juicy and is traditionally served boiled or roasted.



DONGSHAN MUTTON

This dish comes from Wanning. It is notable for its lack of a distinctive mutton flavor. The meat tastes tender and soft after being stewed, roasted, or braised in coconut milk.





OCEAN-TO-TABLE SEAFOOD

The ocean around Sanya is a rich source of seafood, with vendors offering ocean-to-table freshness at reasonable prices. The seafood is prepared in a variety of ways; the same fish can be cooked a dozen different ways to achieve the optimal taste.

COMMON SEAFOOD

Saltwater eels, abalones, drumstick sea snails, sand prawns, sea urchins, Hele crabs, scallops, red crabs, three-spot swimming crabs, oysters, lobster, whelks, edible sharks, sea cucumbers, Napoleon wrasse, oil sea snails, melon sea snails, blackspot tuskfish, and mantis shrimp.

ADVICE FOR TOURISTS

Sanya has a thriving seafood scene, with many seaside restaurants and gourmet plazas. A popular way to experience it is to buy seafood from the Number One Seafood Market in Tianya District. This allows you to experience local life and pick out high-quality ingredients. After shopping, you can cook it yourself or bring your purchase to a nearby restaurant to have it cooked for you.

Seafood prices change with the season but are displayed at the entrance of reputable markets. Before choosing a restaurant, you can check if their prices match the market's. If you encounter fraud or price scams, please call 12345.

Regularly maintained scales are available throughout the city for you to double-check your purchases. When buying seafood, it is acceptable to ask the vendor to cut a small hole in the bottom of the plastic bag to drain excess water. The local rule of thumb for preparing fresh seafood is: the less seasoning, the better. Of course, you can also ask the seafood vendors for cooking advice.

TROPICAL FRUITS

Thanks to its unique tropical climate and soil, Hainan is abundant in delicious, juicy, tropical fruits. A wide variety is available, which taste fresh and unique and have a lustrous, moist appearance. These fruits are not only a feast for the palate but also a work of art for the eyes, making them the perfect gift for family and friends.



ADVICE FOR TOURISTS

In Sanya, it is very easy to purchase delicious fruits at reasonable prices. However, as with everything, moderation is key. Too much of a good thing can lead to discomfort.

Mangoes, lychees, durian, and pineapple contain compounds that may cause mouth sores or other issues if consumed in excess. Specifically, overconsumption of lychee can lead to indigestion, nausea, vomiting, and cold sweats. Other fruits are rich in dietary fiber, and eating too much may cause stomach cramps, gas, or diarrhea. Please consult your tour guide and practice moderation.

LOCAL FLAVORS

Sanya boasts a wide variety of local snacks. With a good appetite and strong legs, you can eat your way through all the streets and alleys of the city. Rice noodle dishes include Hainan noodles, Sanya Gangmen noodles, Wanning Hou'an noodles, Wenchang Baoluo noodles, and Lingshui sour noodles. Glutinous rice delicacies feature rice dumplings with salted egg yolk and meat, sweet rice cakes with coconut shreds, white sugar sponge cakes, and brown sugar sponge cakes. Popular evening snacks include the refreshing Qingbuliang, fruit sorbets, and various barbecue options.

HAINAN RICE NOODLES

This is the most distinctive snack of the Han people in Hainan and a traditional dish of Hainan cuisine. It is made from handmade rice noodles mixed with dark soy sauce, minced garlic, peanut or sesame oil, black bean sprouts, shredded beef, fried shredded squid, fried peanuts, ground roasted sesame seeds, crisp fritters, chopped coriander, chicken cooked with bamboo shoots, pickled Chinese cabbage, and other minor ingredients. The dish is multi-flavored with a rich aroma and a soft, delicate, yet refreshing and tender taste. It becomes even more savory and leaves a lasting aftertaste if you add some hot sea mussel soup to the last few bites.



BAOLUO RICE NOODLES

It is said that Baoluo noodles were already well-known as a delicacy of Baoluo Town in Wenchang during the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644). Served with or without soup, the noodles are made from rice that are blanched, drained, and then dressed with ingredients like fried peanuts, ground roasted sesame seeds, stir-fried bamboo shoots, stir-fried sour pickles, specially made beef jerky, stir-fried shredded pork, heated garlic oil, coriander, and chopped green onion.



GANGMEN RICE NOODLES

This is one of the most authentic dishes in Sanya. It consists of handmade rice noodles dressed with ground pork, pickled Chinese cabbage, bean sprouts, fish cakes, peanuts, and chopped green onion, all topped with a mouth-watering, savory thick broth.



COCONUT RICE CAKE

This famous local Hainanese snack is made from a mixture of rice and glutinous rice, filled with desiccated coconut, peanuts, sesame, and white sugar, making it a highly distinctive delicacy.



QINGBULIANG (HAINANESE COLD DESSERT)

A cool and refreshing dessert, it combines coconut milk, juiced coconut meat, and condensed milk, and is served with an assortment of ingredients like mung beans, red beans, corn, coix seed, watermelon, and bean jelly.



COCONUT CHICKEN

This is a famous Hainanese dish created by the Han people. It perfectly balances color, aroma, and taste. Cooked with coconut and spring chicken, it has a savory, salty flavor and a pleasant coconut aroma. The clear, refreshing soup is believed to replenish vital energy and promote fluid secretion. It is considered beneficial for reducing age-related infirmity, fatigue, irritability, and thirst.



HOU'AN RICE NOODLES

A specialty from Hou'an Town in Wanning, this dish features vermicelli, chopped green onion, and a free-range egg, all topped with pork tripe, large and small intestines, and a piping hot, savory broth.

HAINAN ZONGZI

These pyramid-shaped dumplings are made of glutinous rice wrapped in banana leaves and stuffed with salted egg yolks, barbecued pork, bacon, and braised chicken wings. When you unwrap the hot zongzi, you are first greeted by the delicate aroma of banana leaves and glutinous rice, followed by the rich scent of meat and eggs. The flavors and ingredients are perfectly balanced, making it an appetizing treat. The most famous varieties include Ding'an black pork zongzi, Danzhou Luoji zongzi, and Chengmai Ruixi zongzi.



LINGSHUI SOUR NOODLES

A local Lingshui delicacy, these noodles are round and long, resembling Guilin or Yunnan crossing-the-bridge rice noodles, and boast a distinctive sweet and sour taste. The dish is assembled by combining cooked noodles with a variety of toppings including beef jerky, sliced fish cake, crispy peanuts, boiled leek chunks, and key sauces like sour noodle juice, noodle paste, and garlic oil, finished with coriander and chili sauce. Once mixed, it is ready to enjoy.

FRUIT SORBET

Fruit sorbet is made by continuously stirring a mixture of fresh milk and fruit juice in a pan until it thickens into an icy slush. Served in a transparent container, its colorful appearance is as delightful as its taste. The final product is a cool, refreshing, sweet, and smooth treat that pleases the palate and provides relief from the summer heat.



COCONUT RICE BOAT

Coconut Rice Boat is a famous dessert created by the Han people. Shaped like a boat with coconut meat at the bottom, it is used by locals to pray for well-being and is an ideal food for entertaining distinguished guests, relatives, and friends. Made in a unique way, it is a remarkable natural dish.



THREE COLOR RICE OF THE MIAO PEOPLE

A traditional festive snack of the Miao people from central Hainan's mountainous areas, this dish is especially popular during the "Third Day of the Third Lunar Month" festival. Distinctly Miao in character, it features a delightful contrast of three natural colors—yellow, black, and red—along with an herbal aroma, a sweet, smooth taste, and a beautiful presentation.

LOCAL DRINKS

SHANLAN WINE

Shanlan wine is acclaimed as the "Maotai of the Li ethnic group." The brewing process begins by mixing steamed Shanlan glutinous rice with a unique wine yeast made from a plant exclusive to the Li mountains. The mixture is then wrapped in fresh, clean banana leaves and sealed in a bamboo basket. After seven days, the wine is ready. The pot beneath the basket fills with a milky Shanlan wine, as warm and translucent as white jade. This wine is low in alcohol content and is not intoxicating. It has an enchanting aroma and a lingering sweet taste.



DEER-TORTOISE WINE

It is a health-preserving wine, consisting of astragalus mongholicus, Angelica sinensis, Chinese yam rhizome, goji berry, papaya, cinnamon, rock sugar, and white wine. It is a delicate, aromatic liquid, with a slightly sweet taste and a significant effect on regulating human immune system.



BETEL NUT WINE

Betel nut wine is a new type of low-alcohol health-preserving wine. It is brewed using a scientific method that involves quality betel nut, Shanlan glutinous rice (a specialty of the Li people), ginseng, and other precious traditional Chinese medicines, all steeped in fine mineral water. It has an aromatic and mellow flavor and is believed to offer multiple health benefits, such as deworming, strengthening teeth, refreshing the mind, regulating spirit and pulse, and enhancing vitality and Yang.



REEVES' BUTTERFLY LIZARD WINE

Leiolepis reevesii health-preserving wines are made from Reeves' butterfly lizard, matrimony vine, Carthami Flos, eucommia, Radix Achyranthis Bidentatae, Ligusticum chuanxiong Hort, cordyceps sinensis, astragalus mongholicus, seahorse, sea snake, and other rare traditional Chinese medicines. They are produced using field activation technology and contain essential constants, micronutrients, amino acids, vitamins, and bioactive substances beneficial to the human body. These wines are believed to sustain Yin and strengthen Yang, nourish blood and tranquilize the mind, replenish qi (vitality) deficiency, boost vital energy, promote red blood cell growth, and lower blood pressure. They have a delicate aroma and a lingering sweet taste.



The vendors will prepare them in ways that best preserve their delicate flavor. Once served, you can enjoy your meal with a variety of dipping sauces—such as minced garlic, peanut oil, tomato sauce, mixed sauce, and chopped peanuts—savoring the incredible food in the cool evening breeze.

In Houhai, you can also learn to sail an unpowered sailboat. The hull provides buoyancy and uses the wind for propulsion. When the wind is light, you can easily control the direction. Relax on the boat and take photos, or even drop anchor, jump into the sea for a swim, and enjoy some free diving. Unpowered sailboats make multiple trips to sea each day. We recommend a sunset departure, as it's much cooler and the soft, breathtaking light is perfect for photography.

YALONG BAY TROPICAL PARADISE FOREST PARK


Yalong Bay Tropical Paradise Forest Park is located in the Yalong Bay National Tourism Holiday Resort and covers an area of 1506 hectares. It is the first coastal forest park featuring eco-tourism built in the mountains in Hainan Province. Tropical evergreen plants and tropical semi-deciduous plants form the vegetation of the park. The park is endowed with a variety of resources in the respect of biology, geography, astronomy, hydrology and culture. With the natural landscape in the park, you can enjoy multiple activities including hiking, field activities, sightseeing, wellness-related activities, popular science education, folk customs and culture experience, hot spring spas and sunbathing in the tropical forest. Some parts of the scenic area became the filming locations for the movie "If You Are the One II".



DAY 3

ROAD TRIP AROUND SUNNY BAY

If you are self-driving in Sanya, Taiyangwan (Sunny Bay) Road is a must-visit. It is a new self-driving internet-famous place, attracting many young people to rent roadsters to get there. With a total length of only 6 kilometers, Sunny Bay Road is known as "the most beautiful sea-view road in Yalong Bay". This road is surrounded by the vastness of the sea on one side and the beauty of the mountains with magnificent mangroves on the other. Driving along a road like this makes people exclaim: "This is what I call a real vacation and an amazing self-driving experience!" Such a spectacular view with the azure sea and the seaside road inspires travelers to capture great masterpieces. There is the only viewing platform in the middle of the road section, where you have an opportunity to enjoy the beautiful scenery of Yalong Bay on the left and Sunny Bay on the right at the same time.



2.EXPLORE THE HIDDEN GEM BAIFU BAY

"Bai Fu Bay" is located in the southwestern part of Yalong Bay in Sanya City, adjacent to Taiyang Bay. Compared to the bustling Yalong Bay, this area is exceptionally quiet and serene, as if it were a corner forgotten by time. The bay is crescent-shaped, with a coastline stretching approximately 2.5 kilometers. Surrounded by mountains on three sides and facing the sea on the fourth, its unique terrain has endowed it with exceptional natural conditions. The coral reefs in Bai Fu Wan are among the best-preserved coral reefs in Yalong Bay. A hidden gem, a diver's paradise, crystal-clear glass-like waters, and Instagram-worthy glass-bottom boats—every scene here is picture-perfect. The seabed teems with soft corals and various marine life. Due to minimal external disturbance, the bay's waters are crystal-clear, with visibility reaching up to 30 meters, rivaling the waters of the Maldives. It is one of China's premier diving destinations.

PART5 SANYA ECONOMIC CIRCLE

RECOMMENDED TRAVEL ROUTES IN THE SANYA ECONOMIC CIRCLE

Across mountains and seas, we breathe the same air. Sanya joins hands with Lingshui, Baoting, Ledong, and Wuzhishan—regions rich in tropical rainforest resources and vibrant ethnic cultures—to build a unique Sanya Economic Circle. From Lingshui's Nanwan Monkey Island to the Diaoluo Mountain National Forest Park; from Baoting's Yanoda Rainforest Cultural and Tourist Zone to the Li and Miao Cultural Park in Betelnut Valley; and from the Jianfeng Ridge National Forest Park, Maogong Mountain, to the Wuzhishan Red Canyon Cultural Tourist Area—all are destinations worthy of exploration.



LINGSHUI LI AUTONOMOUS COUNTY

Lingshui Li Autonomous County is located in southeastern Hainan Island, bordering Sanya to the south at a direct distance of 70 kilometers. It covers an area of 1,128 square kilometers and is largely inhabited by the Han, Li, and Miao peoples, who live in mixed communities. It is known as the "Natural Greenhouse" and a "Treasure Land for Tropical Crops," and is home to world-famous cultured seawater pearls and a fascinating, diverse bay landscape. Local specialties include Lingshui sour rice noodles, clams, and fish congee.

BOUNDARY ISLAND ECO-CULTURAL TOURISM RESORT (National AAAA scenic spot)

The Niuling ("Cow Ridge") mountain ridge on Boundary Island forms the dividing line between northern and southern East Hainan Island. The north of the island is mostly flat, while the south is hilly. This topography creates a distinct climatic difference, leading to the common spectacle of "rain on the cow's head and sun on the cow's tail" on Niuling. With its beautiful scenery and rich seabed resources, Boundary Island is an ideal place for sightseeing and water sports.

BOUNDARY ISLAND SCENIC SPOT

Located at the junction of Wanning City and Lingshui Li Autonomous County in Hainan Province, China, it is administered by Lingshui Li Autonomous County. Heavenly pearls and magical creations. Due to its unique geographical location, variable climate, peculiar island terrain, and distinctive regional cultural characteristics, Boundary Island Scenic Spot has been known since ancient times as "Fenjiezhou Island" and "Beauty Island."

Along the East Ring Expressway and East Ring Railway, you can see the full view of Boundary Island Scenic Spot nestled in the blue sea. Fenjiezhou Island leverages its stunning tropical natural island resources to offer visitors a wide range of highly experiential, personalized marine tourism activities. These include diving, deep-sea fishing, jet-skiing, and other marine tourism projects, as well as interactive experiences where visitors can get up close and personal with marine animals such as sea turtles and tropical fish. Fenjiezhou Island is a destination renowned for its diverse array of marine tourism activities in Hainan.



BAOTING LI AND MIAO AUTONOMOUS COUNTY



Located in the south of Hainan Island, the county is characterized by green mountains, lucid waters, and a year-round summer atmosphere. Its beautiful scenery, emblematic of southern China, is composed of sunshine, coconut groves, betel nut palms, and various tropical fruit plantations. Blessed with fertile land, abundant rainfall, ample sunshine, and a mild climate, the county is rich in natural resources. These include tropical rainforests, hot springs, magnificent peaks, stone forests, karst caves, rambutan orchards, and vibrant ethnic customs, all of which have won domestic and international acclaim.

BINGLANGGU LI & MIAO CULTURAL HERITAGE PARK (NATIONAL AAAA SCENIC SPOT)



Situated in Ganshiling at the junction of Baoting Li and Miao Autonomous County and Sanya, the park covers an area of 300 mu (20 hectares). Located just 28 kilometers from Sanya, it is a national nature reserve where you can encounter green mountains, clear waters, birds, flowers, towering ancient trees, and hundred-year-old betel nut forests. The valley's clean, fresh air makes it a rare natural oxygen bar and a gene bank of flora and fauna. The area is largely inhabited by the Li and Miao people, known for their kindness, friendliness, honesty, and simplicity. Binglanggu, or Betel Nut Valley, fosters an ancient culture rooted in the civilization of southern China, centered around Li and Miao customs, and connected through its tropical ecological gardens. It is renowned as the "Holy Land of the Li and Miao Customs," an oasis for returning to simplicity and nature, and an ideal destination to visit in Hainan.



LEDONG LI AUTONOMOUS COUNTY



It is located in the southwest of Hainan, backed by mountains and facing the sea. It is adjacent to the famous tourist city Sanya in the southeast, which is about one hour away by car. It has the largest population, the largest land area, and cultural edge among all the ethnic autonomous counties in Hainan. It is acclaimed as "natural greenhouse", "treasure land for tropical crops plantation", "tourist attraction", "botanical oasis", and "the home of cashew nuts". It also has the largest Yinggehai salt field in southern China and the Yinggehai oil and gas field under development.

JIANFENGLING NATIONAL FOREST PARK

Jianfengling was approved by the Ministry of Forestry to establish a national forest park in 1992, making it the only forest park characterized by tropical rainforests in China. It measures about 1,600 hectares, mainly for the protection of tropical virgin rainforests and rare animals such as gibbons and peacock-pheasants. Jianfengling is China's first national tropical rainforest park, with the largest and best-preserved tropical virgin forest in the country. It has a wide and distinctive variety of tropical forest vegetation and abundant wildlife species. In addition to tree ferns (Cyatheales), a living fossil plant from the age of dinosaurs more than 200 million years ago, it is also home to more than 20 nationally protected species that are rare to find. The natural and ecological landscape is original, majestic and wonderful. There is a basin enveloped by mountains to the east of Heiling Ridge in Jianfengling. Shrouded in wreathing clouds all day long, the basin is called "Tianchi" (Heavenly Lake). From the top of the mountain, you can enjoy the "spectacle of four seas", which are the sea of forest, sea of clouds, sea of fog and the real sea.



WUZHISHAN CITY

Wuzhishan Mountain is located in the hinterland of the central and southern part of Hainan Island. Wuzhishan Mountain is named because its rolling peaks look like five fingers. Its main peak is 1867 meters above sea level. It is the highest peak in Hainan and is known as "the roof ridge of Hainan" and "the top of the South China Sea". Wuzhishan City is the ecological core area and the main river source of Hainan, known as the "water source", "water tower" and "the source of the three rivers". It enjoys the reputation of "the lung of Hainan" and "Emerald Mountain City" because of its four seasons without extreme heat and cold, sufficient water and heat, and abundant oxygen.

WUZHISHAN RED CANYON CULTURAL TOURIST AREA

Wuzhishan Red Canyon Cultural Tourist Area is located in Nansheng Town, Wuzhishan City, Hainan Province, 12 kilometers away from Wuzhishan urban area, is the focus of Wuzhishan City to create the national AAAA tourist attractions. Wuzhishan Red Canyon Cultural Tourist Area takes the rain forest and canyon drift of Wuzhishan Mountain as the theme, and relies on Li and Miao culture as the foundation to excavate the connotation of Chinese health preservation culture. Multi-cultural elements are implanted to form a complex scenic spot integrating sightseeing, vacation, recreation and health preservation. The scenic area has been opened to the Red Gorge Drift, warrior's Path, True CS, camping barbecue, specialty restaurant, step by step surprise, pedal boat and other eight major projects.





GETTING TO SANYA

With the largest international airport in the south of Hainan Island, the Hainan Ring High-speed Railway, and the Phoenix Island International Terminal, Sanya has a fully integrated system of air, road, and sea transportation. No matter which transportation you choose, a smooth and convenient journey awaits you.

BY AIR



Sanya Phoenix International Airport, located about 11 kilometers west of downtown, serves as a crucial gateway connecting Sanya to the world. Additionally, both Haikou Meilan International Airport and Qionghai Bo'ao International Airport are accessible from the city via high-speed rail.

SANYA PHOENIX INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (Sanya Phoenix International Airport Station)

Sanya Phoenix International Airport is located approximately 11 kilometers west of downtown Sanya and commenced operations in July 1994. As a 4E-category regional hub airport, it is fully capable of handling large wide-body aircraft such as Boeing 747 and Airbus A340 at maximum takeoff weight.

The airport currently operates two passenger terminals, serving numerous domestic and international carriers including Hainan Airlines (HU), China Southern Airlines (CZ), China Eastern Airlines (MU), Hong Kong Airlines (HX), Aeroflot (SU), Air Astana (KC), SCAT Airlines (DV), Belavia (B2), and Condor Flugdienst (DE). Its route network connects major provincial capitals across China, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, as well as international destinations in Russia, Belarus, South Korea, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Singapore, Cambodia, Mongolia, Thailand and other countries along the Belt and Road Initiative. Through continuous development, the airport has established a comprehensive aviation network, achieving an annual passenger throughput that surpasses 20 million travelers.

HAIKOU MEILAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (IATA:HAK)

Haikou Meilan International Airport, which opened in May 1999, is located about 270 kilometers from downtown. Adjacent to Meilan Railway Station, it offers convenient access to high-speed rail services, with the bullet train to Sanya taking just 1 hour and 40 minutes.

As one of China's key aviation hubs, Haikou Meilan International Airport is currently undergoing Phase 2 expansion to achieve 4F classification standards. The airport has earned multiple prestigious accolades from Skytrax, including: Five-Star Regional Airport Rating (2017) - becoming only the eighth airport worldwide to receive this distinction; Five-Star Airport Rating renewal (2019) along with the title of "Best Regional Airport in China".

QIONGHAI BO'AO AIRPORT (IATA:BAR)

Qionghai Bo'ao Airport, located in Zhongyuan County (Qionghai City), is approximately 160 kilometers from Sanya. The high-speed rail connection from Bo'ao Railway Station to Sanya takes just one hour. This 4C-class airport, which commenced operations in March 2016, serves as an important complement to Sanya and Haikou's aviation facilities. The airport is served by multiple airlines including: China Eastern Airlines (MU), Hainan Airlines (HU), Suparna Airlines (Y8), 9 Air (AQ). It offers numerous domestic routes to major Chinese cities such as Beijing, Shanghai, and Guangzhou.

BY RAIL

Sanya enjoys direct rail connectivity to mainland China via the Guangdong-Hainan Railway, China's first cross-sea rail route, with regular train services linking major cities like Beijing and Guangzhou directly to Sanya. As a key node on the Hainan Ring High-Speed Railway, Sanya offers frequent and efficient high-speed train services to destinations across the island, including Haikou, Wenchang, Dongfang, and other cities, providing passengers with fast and convenient travel options.

SANYA RAILWAY STATION

Sanya Railway Station is located at Yuxiu Road, Jiyang District. As the most important railway station in Sanya, it is also the departure and arrival station of Guangdong-Hainan regular train, Hainan East Ring High-Speed Railway and Hainan West Ring High-Speed Railway.

FENGHUANGJICHANG RAILWAY STATION

Fenghuangjichang Railway Station is located at Jichang Road, Tianya District. It is connected with Sanya Phoenix International Airport through a transfer platform bridge, offering an excellent experience of seamless plane-train transfer.

YALONGWAN RAILWAY STATION

The easternmost station in Sanya, Yalongwan Railway Station is located at Gaoxin Road, Jiyang District. Passengers arriving at this station can visit Yalong Bay, which enjoys a reputation of being "the best bay in the world".

YAZHOU RAILWAY STATION

Sitting at north of Gucheng Road, Yazhou District, Yazhou Railway Station is the westernmost station in Sanya and the closest one to Yazhou Ancient City. This railway station is divided into a high-speed session and a regular session.

BY EXPRESSWAY

The main expressways in Sanya are the Hainan Island Ring Expressway and the Tongjiang-Sanya Expressway, with the latter spanning 5,700 kilometers — making it the longest route in China's "Five Vertical and Seven Horizontal" National Trunk Highway System. Drivers benefit from toll-free access, well-maintained roads, and comprehensive facilities.

BY CRUISE SHIP

Sanya Phoenix Island International Cruise Terminal in Sanya Bay holds the distinction of being China's first international cruise port. Its operational berths are capable of accommodating 80,000-ton cruise ships, making it Asia's largest home port for international cruises. With an annual capacity of 2 million visitors, the terminal represents a major hub for maritime tourism.



GETTING AROUND SANYA

BY BUS

Upon arrival at Sanya Airport, you can take a convenient bus directly to your hotel. To take the airport bus, you will need to walk to the bus ticket office opposite Gate 5 to purchase your ticket and wait for the bus to pick you up. Considering the demand for convenient transportation among tourists, Ctrip Group Hainan Company has partnered with over 60 high-end hotels to launch a free shuttle bus service. Currently, over 60 high-end hotels in areas such as Sanya Bay, Yalong Bay, and Haitang Bay have already joined this service network. In daily travel, the public transportation network in Sanya is very well-developed, with routes reaching almost everywhere in the city. So far, there are altogether 132 bus lines and 23 operating origin and destination stations.

The distance-graduated fare system is applied in Sanya, with an initial fare of 2 Yuan, gradually increasing depending on the distance traveled. A trip in the city usually costs about 2 to 12 Yuan. The core hours of the service will be from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.

The tram line in Sanya is also very convenient. It has 15 stations and runs from Sanya Railway station to Jiangang Road.

Many hotels (resorts) offer free shuttle buses to the city center and various attractions. You may consult the hotel staff for the route information and the timetable.

BY TAXI

Depending on the car model and the comfort level, there are two types of taxis in Sanya, Type 1 and Type 2. For Type 1, the initial charge is 11 Yuan with 2.5 kilometers, and 2.4 Yuan per kilometer for additional distances. For Type 2, the initial charge is 10 Yuan with 2.5 kilometers, and 2.2 Yuan per kilometer for additional distances. In addition, night-time trips between 11:00 pm and 6:00 am the next day will cost 20% more than in day hours.

You can also communicate with hotel staff at the front desk of your hotel, explain your destination and needs, and ask them to help you coordinate transportation for a hassle-free trip.



RIDING THE SANYA URBAN TRAM

The Sanya Tram Demonstration Line Project is the first tram line in China to be constructed using the PPP model, and also the first urban rail transit line in Hainan Province. Spanning 8.37 kilometers, the line features 15 stations, with a unique island-inspired design, a sleek, modern tram head, and large windows, making it an excellent choice for sightseeing. Utilizing advanced electric drive technology, it operates with zero emissions and low noise, making it a true green mode of transportation. It not only reduces air pollution caused by traditional fuel-powered vehicles but also provides passengers with a quiet and comfortable riding environment. The one-way fare for the tram is three yuan. Passengers can purchase tickets at the station ticket machines.

Ticket purchasing process:

Select destination → Confirm number of tickets → Cash/mobile payment → Ticket issuance → Collect ticket.

If you are unable to purchase a ticket at the platform in time, you may board the tram first and settle the fare with the train staff onboard.

Cash payment process:

Hand cash to the staff → Staff operate the device to settle the fare → Print the fare settlement receipt → Collect the fare settlement receipt.

Mobile payment process:

Use WeChat/Alipay/China Unionpay Quick Pass "Scan" function → Scan the fare settlement QR code in the carriage → Confirm the payment amount and pay → Present the payment receipt to board the tram.



BIKE SHARE

Nothing compares to the pleasure of a bike ride to feel the beauty of the coastal city. Enjoying fresh air, gorgeous scenery and beautiful beaches, you will reveal the most romantic side of Sanya with a bike ride along the sea. Most hotels in Sanya have bikes for rent. For short rides, you can also take a shared bike from Meituan, Qingju or Mobike, which can be found everywhere in the city.



CAR RENTAL AND SELF-DRIVING

Car rental business is very popular in Sanya. From economy cars, luxury vehicles to SUV, there is a wide range of options for you. When you arrive at the "city of sports cars", you need an unusual sports car to enjoy the unusual experience. A cool roadster is just the perfect match for the blue sky and vast ocean in this romantic place. At present, both international companies like Hertz and Avis and domestic ones like eHi and Shenzhou are operating in Sanya, providing convenient options for you to collect and return the vehicle at the airport, railway stations and the major bay areas.

LUGGAGE STORAGE

Sanya has introduced an innovative luggage-handling service to enhance tourism convenience.

Partnering with SF Express, the "Easy Travel in Sanya" program allows visitors to:

- Send luggage directly from Phoenix Airport/Sanya Railway Station to hotels
- Return luggage from hotels to transit hubs before departure
- Order via QR code at service stations for seamless processing

Tourists can conveniently place luggage delivery orders by scanning SF Express QR codes at designated service stations. The "Easy Travel in Sanya" service offers complete luggage handling solutions: Upon arrival at Sanya Phoenix International Airport or railway station, visitors may scan the code at delivery points to arrange luggage transfer to their hotels. SF Express guarantees timely delivery based on requested timeframes. For departure, guests simply place orders at their hotels and leave luggage at the front desk for SF Express to collect and deliver to transportation hubs. Additionally, SF Express provides three tiered delivery options to accommodate varying schedules:

Express Delivery (1-3 hours):

Priority same-day courier service with dedicated personnel for urgent luggage transfers.

Standard Delivery (4-8 hours):

Scheduled van service operating on fixed routes for reliable timed deliveries.

Economy Delivery (8+ hours):

Cost-effective regular express service with special travel discounts included.

BANKS CURRENCY EXCHANGE AND CREDIT CARDS

The Chinese Yuan, also known as Renminbi (人民币, "people's money"), is the official currency of China and is used throughout mainland China. Its basic unit is the Yuan (symbol: ¥).

Currency Structure:

1 Yuan = 10 Jiao (or Mao)

1 Jiao = 10 Fen

Banknotes and Coins:

Issued by the People's Bank of China in denominations of:

Yuan: 1, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100

Jiao/Mao and Fen: Coins in 1 and 5

For many travelers, currency exchange is often necessary during their trips, especially for business travelers in China. Foreign exchange services are typically available at major banks, hotels, and airports. Since exchange rates fluctuate, it's highly recommended to check the current value of the yuan before your departure.

When traveling in Sanya, note that electronic payments are accepted in over 95% of transactions. We recommend using Alipay or WeChat Pay by linking your bank card for QR code payments. International visitors can either activate Alipay's "TourPass" prepaid service or link their Visa/Mastercard directly to WeChat (ensure cross-border payment functionality is enabled).

With the increase in tourist numbers, Sanya is also improving its service quality and working hard to provide easy and convenient solutions for international tourists to make payments in Hainan. Now tourists can make mobile payments by AliPay or WeChat with an international bank card linked to the account, or pay for their taxi rides directly with a Visa or MasterCard credit card issued abroad.

CULTURAL NEEDS

SOUTH MOSQUE (THE LARGEST MOSQUE IN SANYA CITY)

Address: No. 1380 Jiefang Road, Huixin Village, Tianya District, Sanya City.

History and Scale: Originally built during the Southern Song Dynasty (over 900 years ago), it was reconstructed between 2013 and 2016. The building covers an area of 4,450 square meters and can accommodate 3,200 people for prayer simultaneously. It serves as the core religious site and cultural landmark for Muslims in Sanya.

Facilities: The main building is grand in scale, featuring a prayer hall, a Quranic school, and other facilities, combining religious activities with cultural exchange functions.

DONG MOSQUE

Address: 100 meters southwest of the intersection of Fenghuang Road and County Road 827, Tianya District.

Features: The building is green and white in Islamic style, with three iconic semi-circular domes on the top and the words "Qingzhen Dongsi Mosque" inscribed above the door. It provides daily worship and scripture education services.

BEIDA MOSQUE

Address: East side of Huihui Neighborhood Committee, Tianya District (near Phoenix Airport).

History: Originally built at the end of the Song Dynasty, it has been destroyed and rebuilt many times. The current mosque was expanded in 1993 and can accommodate 200-300 people for worship.

Functions: In addition to religious activities, it has a teaching building that offers bilingual Chinese-Arabic education.

TO BE OR NOT TO BE?
Chinese does not have words for "yes" and "no" as such; instead, questions are typically answered by repeating the verb. Here are common examples:
To be or not to be: **[Shi], [Bú Shì]**
To have or not have/there is or is not: **[Yǒu], [Méi Yǒu]**
To be right or wrong: **[Dui], [Bú Dui]**
If all this seems like too much to handle, you can say "yes" with a short falling-tone grunt(Èng**), and you'll usually be understood if you say**[Bù]** for "no"**
